Audition Part 1: Students should be able to answer the following questions during the in-person audition:

1. Introduce yourself: Provide your name and why you want to participate in the Drama summer intensive.

2. What inspired your curiosity for Drama?

3. What's your favorite play or musical?

Audition Part 2:

During in-person auditions

1. Students must prepare and perform a one-minute age-appropriate monologue from a published play. Monologue books are available through local libraries and bookstores or online
2. Be sure to state your name, character name and title of your piece. Say, "Hi, my name is (your name) and I will be doing (character) from the play (name of play)". Then begin your audition
3. Students should prepare a vocal selection. (Preferably from musical theatre) You can sing to a recorded instrumental track or acappella. *Optional
4. Auditioning students will also be required to demonstrate an ability to read "cold" from a provided script.
5. Wear clothes and shoes that allow you to move freely.
