Drama

Audition Part 1: Students should be able to answer the following questions during the in-person audition:

- **1. Introduce yourself:** Provide your name and why you want to participate in the Drama summer intensive.
- 2. What inspired your curiosity for Drama?
- 3. What's your favorite play or musical?

Audition Part 2:

During in-person auditions

- 1. Students must prepare and perform a one-minute age-appropriate monologue from a published play. Monologue books are available through local libraries and bookstores or online
- 2. Be sure to state your name, character name and title of your piece. Say, "Hi, my name is (your name) and I will be doing (character) from the play (name of play)". Then begin your audition
- 3. Students should prepare a vocal selection. (Preferably from musical theatre) You can sing to a recorded instrumental track or acappella. *Optional
- 4. Auditioning students will also be required to demonstrate an ability to read "cold" from a provided script.
- 5. Wear clothes and shoes that allow you to move freely.
